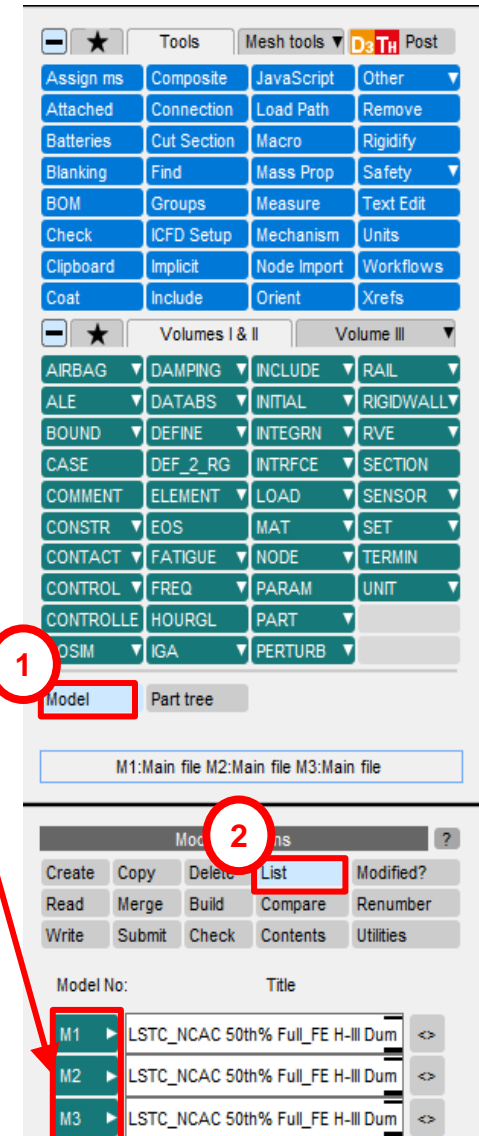


# Working with Multiple Models



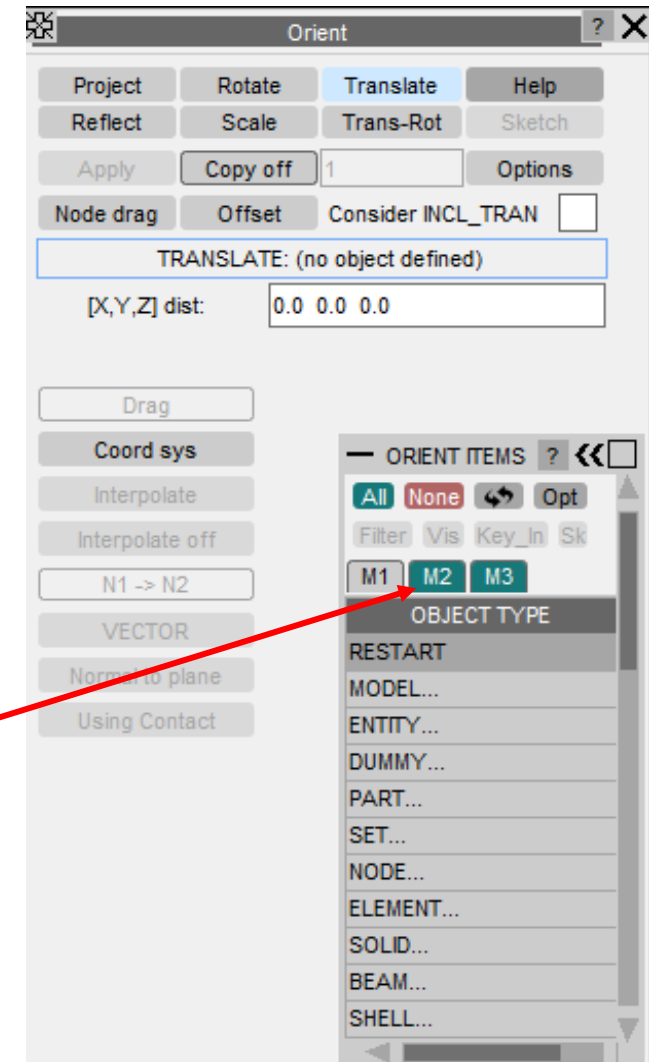
# Working with multiple models

- In PRIMER it is possible to load more than one model into the PRIMER window.
- It is also possible to change which models you would like to view, so that only entities associated with this model will be shown.
- A **red** background to the model number means that particular model is not active in the graphics window, while a **green** background tells us that this is the active model in the graphics window.
- It is possible to have more than one active model in the graphics window.



# Multiple models object selection menu

- In this example we have used the object selection menu from within the Orient function, however the same principles are applied across all the tools.
- When there is more than one model present in PRIMER, the object selection menu will allow you to show/hide all the entities relating to a specific model.
- The buttons indicate which model entities are visible in the selection list; grey means that models entities cannot be seen, but green indicates that models entities can be seen.
